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Description of Work:

WPC provided all necessary labor, equipment and materials in order to construct an RD Wastewater Treatment Plant Replacement for the city of Monticello. The project saw the incorporation of a grit removal system at the existing influent structure. A 0.8 MGD oxidation ditch with integral anaerobic and anoxic zones was added. Additionally, two (2) 55-foot diameter clarifiers, and RAS/w AS pump station were incorporated. Further additions were, a 0.23 MGD aeration system, digester blowers, a chlorine contact chamber and chlorination facilities.



Three (3) precast buildings were included to house the aforementioned chlorine feed/storage facilities, as well as the blowers and control electric room. An effluent pumping system and in plant reuse systems were also new items. WPC also performed upgrades to the existing in-plant pump station. Finally, all associated site work was also performed by WPC such as yard piping and electrical in order to have a fully functioning Wastewater Treatment Plant.
